

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND, REVISE, AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER 381 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF CLIFTON, ENTITLED "SMOKING ON MUNICIPAL PROPERTY" (PROHIBITS SMOKING IN PARKS AND RECREATIONAL FACILITIES)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipal Council of the City of Clifton that:

1. Chapter 381 of the Code of the City of Clifton, entitled "Smoking on Municipal Property," is hereby amended, revised and supplemented as follows:

CHAPTER 381
SMOKING ON MUNICIPAL PROPERTY

§ 381-1. Definitions.

As used in this chapter, the following words shall have the following meanings:

PARKS AND RECREATIONAL FACILITIES -- All public parks, playgrounds, ball fields, publicly owned or leased by the City of Clifton and all property owned or leased by the City of Clifton upon which the public is invited or upon which the public is permitted and where individuals gather for recreational activities, including all areas adjacent to such facilities including, but not limited to, any parking area, driveway or drive aisle.

SMOKING -- The burning of, inhaling from, exhaling the smoke from, or the possession of a lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe or any other matter or substance which contains tobacco or any other matter that can be smoked, or the inhaling or exhaling of smoke or vapor from an electronic smoking device.

§ 381-2. Prohibition of smoking in public places; signs.

A. and B. *No changes.*

C. Smoking shall be prohibited in all public parks, playgrounds, ball fields, publicly owned or leased by the City of Clifton and all property owned or leased by the City of Clifton upon which the public is invited or upon which the public is permitted and where individuals gather for recreational activities, including all areas adjacent to such facilities including, but not limited to, any parking area, driveway or drive aisle, which have been designated with no-smoking signs. No smoking signs or the international no smoking symbol (consisting of a pictorial representation of a burning cigarette enclosed in a red circle with a diagonal red line through its cross section) shall be clearly, sufficiently and conspicuously posted in all areas regulated by this Chapter. The signs shall be clearly visible to the public and shall contain letters or a symbol which contrast in color with the sign, indicating that smoking is prohibited at the designated area. The sign shall also indicate that violators are subject to a fine.
